

INVISIBLE LEARNING BARRIERS

Traditional learning barriers, like absence and lack of attention, are easy to spot. But what about the barriers you can't see?



ECHO:

- **ASHA** recommends reverberation times of less than **.4 seconds**
- Most classrooms have reverberation times of up to 1.25 seconds



STUDENT-TEACHER DISTANCE:

- It is **40%** more difficult to learn when far away from the teacher
- **90%** of first-grade students miss at least some information



BACKGROUND NOISE:

- **ANSI** recommends **35** decibels as "acceptable"
- Most learning spaces range **41-51**
