

FrontRow Juno Localization Instructions



The latest versions of the FrontRow Desktop for Mac OS and Windows allow you to localize your Juno Tower to a particular language or region for voice command functionality.

Some Juno Towers have already been localized prior to shipment, but in order to ensure that you get future updates appropriate to your region, you must first perform a **one-time** setup by following the steps below.

Once localization is completed, you will receive notification of future firmware updates specific to your locale. When you receive a notification, simply click the update button and the appropriate version will be loaded onto your Juno Tower.



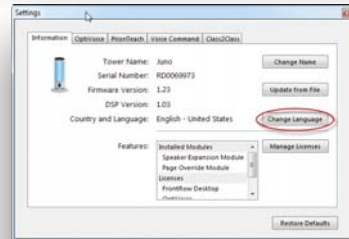
FrontRow Desktop for Windows

1. Click the Tools button

2. Click the Change Language button



3. Choose language / region and click OK



4. Click Start Update and follow the on screen / Tower LCD prompts

FrontRow Desktop for Mac OS

1. Under the FrontRow Desktop menu, click Preferences

2. In the Preferences window, click the dropdown next to Country / Language and choose the appropriate language / region



3. Click Change Language to confirm and follow the on screen / Tower LCD prompts
